
FINGHIN COLLINS (PIANO)

One of the most significant musicians to emerge from Ireland in recent times, Finghin Collins was born in Dublin in 1977 and studied with John O'Conor at the Royal Irish Academy of Music and with Dominique Merlet at the Geneva Conservatoire.
