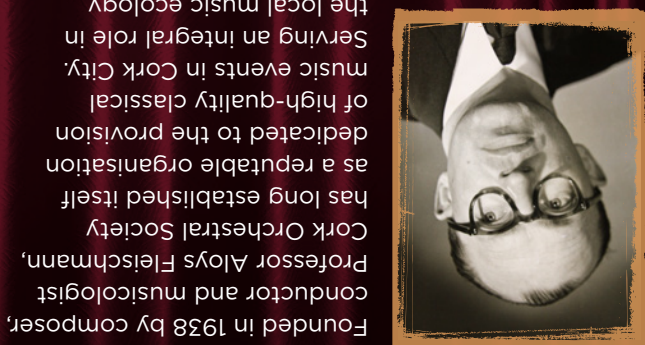


About Cork Orchestral Society



Founded in 1938 by composer, conductor and musicologist Professor Aloys Fleischmann, Cork Orchestral Society has long established itself as a reputable organisation dedicated to the provision of high-quality classical music events in Cork City. Serving an integral role in the local music ecology and wider national infrastructure, the Society presents concerts throughout the year in a varied programme of chamber, choral and orchestral music, inviting audiences to experience the very best of local, national and international performers and ensembles.

In recent years, the Society has programmed performances by the National Symphony Orchestra, RTE Concert Orchestra and Irish Chamber Orchestra, as well as supporting Cork-based music-making and early-career musicians. Cork Orchestral Society is supported with funding from both the Arts Council and Cork City Council, and its long-standing partnership with MTU Cork School of Music.

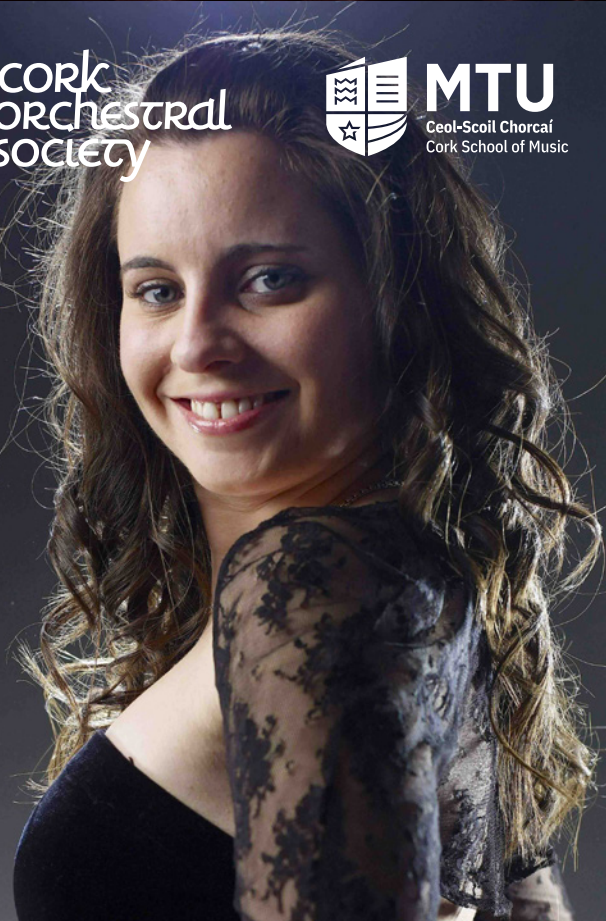

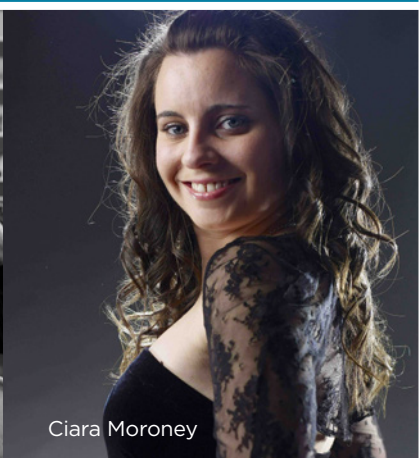
